Intersectionality and the Capabilities Approach

Categories as gender, class and race/ethnicity have a high impact with regard to social inequality. The term Intersectionality covers a theoretical access that tries to take into account such socially relevant categories as powerful interacting differences. In which way could the Capabilities Approach add a further relevant perspective to a theoretical framework that is concerned with “differences that make a difference” and inequality.

Dissertation projects should analyse the relation between Intersectionality and the CA theoretically.
